  - job search
  - job matching
  - rich career content
  - career counseling
  - information on Job Fairs
  - services of local service providers like drivers, plumbers, etc. for households and various other services.
- ▶ This portal facilitates registration of Job Seekers, Employers, Skill Providers, Career Counselors, Local Service Providers (LSP's), Career Centers, Placement Organizations & Households (for availing the services of the LSP's).



# Benefits - NCS


