## Sector

- Refers to a large segment of the economy.
- There are three sectors of the Indian economy.
  - **Primary sector** – Products that we get from the nature belongs to primary sector, such as agriculture.
  - **Secondary sector** – The manufacturing sector where the goods are produced can be classified as secondary sector
  - **Tertiary Sector** – The service sector can be classified as Tertiary sector



## Primary sector

- Products that we get from the nature.
- Primary sector includes mainly agriculture, forestry, fishing, mining, and quarrying.



## Secondary sector

- This sector has industries that are involved in manufacturing of a finished product or are in construction.
- Secondary sector comprises of activities like Manufacturing, construction, infrastructure etc.



## Tertiary Sector

- The sector comprises of services.
- Tertiary sector includes mainly the service industry like trade, hotel, transport, communication, banking and finance, public administration, defence etc.



## Industry

Describes a much more specific group or a narrowed focus of businesses.

**Example:**

### **Agriculture Industry**

Agriculture industry consists of cultivating land, plants and breeding animals to produce foods and other survival things. After that, the agriculture industry has been growing exponentially.

This industry consists of producing, providing, selling and exporting agricultural goods. This industry provides employment to researchers, scientists, biotechnicians, veterinarians, farm labors and development technicians.





## India's Economic Sector
