

Types of Computer Accessories

 - **Modem** – Connects your home network to the internet.
 - **LAN Cable (Ethernet)** – Wired internet connection.

5. Comfort and Productivity Accessories

These improve comfort, efficiency, or usability.

- **Laptop Stand / Cooling Pad** – Raises laptop height and improves cooling.
 - **External Monitor** – Adds a second screen for multitasking.
 - **Docking Station** – Expands ports for laptops.
 - **External Keyboard & Mouse** – Used with laptops or desktops for comfort.
 - **UPS (Uninterruptible Power Supply)** – Provides backup power during outages.
 - **Webcam Covers** – For privacy.
 - **Cable Organizers** – Keeps wires tidy and organized.
