
Ques.1- Elaborate the process & elements of Communication in detail through suitable examples.

- Channel



ELEMENTS OF COMMUNICATION: -There are two types of communication elements: -

- 1. Based on communication channel
- 2. Based on style and purpose



BASED ON COMMUNICATION CHANNEL: -

- <u>NON-VERBAL COMMUNICATION</u> –It refers to the transmission of messages or signals though a non verbal platform such as eye contact, facial expressions, gestures, postures and the distance between two individuals.
- <u>VERBAL COMMUNICATION</u>: -It is the use of sounds and words to express you, especially in contrast to using gestures or mannerisms. It has two types –

- 1. Written
- 2. Oral

Oral type of verbal communication is further divided into two types:

- 1. Face-to-Face
- 2. Distance

BASED ON STYLE AND PURPOSE:-

- FORMAL COMMUNICATION: -It refers to the flow of official through proper, predefined channels and routes. The flow of information is controlled and needs deliberate effort to be properly communicated. It follows a hierarchical structure and chain of command.
- <u>INFORMAL COMMUNICATION</u>: It is a casual and unofficial form of communication wherein the information is exchanged spontaneously between two or more persons without conforming the prescribed official rules, processes, system, formalities and chain of command.

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
