Scheme Details

- **Disability Type/Category-** Orthopaedic / Locomotor and Speech & Hearing Impaired only
- **Minimum 40% disability with valid disability certificate**
- **Documents required-** Certified copy of Disability certificate, Aadhar Card, Bank Details/Passbook & Educational Certificates.
- Applicant must not have undergone any other skill training course sponsored by Govt. of India during the period of two years from the last date of receipt of application.

Scheme is only for Disable candidates.

- Minimum attendance 80%
- The candidate will get Rs. 1000 per month (as per course duration) in his/her Aadhar linked Bank Account as per the Attendance who complete the training programme and is successfully certified (depends on scheme)*.
- Additional Rs 5000 as an assistive aid to beneficiary.
- Assessment Examination Council – SCPwDCertifying Authority- NSDC (Ministry of Skill Development and Entrepreneurship)
